

The FMIF Income account should be renamed **the St Peter's Church C.B.F. Account**. In addition to the current balance in this account of £5,094 the following balances, currently held in the **C.B.F General Reserves account** will be transferred to **the St. Peter's Church C.B.F. account**

Long Term Maintenance Fund	£647

St Leonard's Church C.B.F. Account is already in existence with a balance of £60.

It is proposed that the following balances currently held in the **C.B.F. General Reserve account** should be transferred to **St Leonard's Church C.B.F. account**:

Ethel Leach Memorial Income	£5,836
St Leonard's General Purpose	£57

After the above transfers have taken place the **C.B.F General Reserves Account** will contain only unrestricted funds for the P.C.C. use and will have a current balance of £1,413

The Ethel Leach Memorial Fund and the **Fabric Maintenance and Improvement Trust** endowment funds will continue to remain separate and governed under their respective legal declarations of trust.

The regular donations for **Chairs for St Peter's Church** which have formed part of the current account balance should have a separate C.B.F. account opened for this specific cause.

The other existing C.B.F. accounts will remain.

These are the **St Peter's Church Tower Fund** and the **St Peter's Bells Fund**.
